1. **Always remember that I am a guest of the local culture.** As a representative of both Lee University and Christ during the COMMART domestic cross cultural experience, I realize the importance of my compliance with standards of conduct and dress, as well as those of the local Christian people.
2. **Develop and maintain a servant’s attitude toward everyone at all times.** That includes all tour guides, trip members and hosts.
3. **Always show respect for my team leader(s) and their decisions.**
4. **Refrain from gossip.**
5. **Refrain from complaining.** Travel can create many problems and uncomfortable circumstances, but the rewards of conquering these are innumerable.
6. **Respect the particular churches, media organizations, agencies, or persons in London, Paris, & Lisbon with which we are collaborating.** I realize that our team will be there for a short period of time, but the objectives of the media organizations and the Lee University program is long term. Therefore, I will respect their knowledge, vision, insights and instructions.
7. **Attend all trip meetings.** I will be prompt for all trip events as a courtesy to other trip members. This applies to meetings before and during the trip. Additionally, I agree to be present at all activities of the program, including classes. Repeated absences from preparatory trip meetings (at the University) will be met with dismissal from the opportunity to participate in the trip.
8. **Fulfill all logistical requirements.** I will comply with all requirements regarding registration, finances, health clinic formalities, etc.
9. **Refrain from negative comments (political, cultural, etc.) concerning the host city that we are visiting.**
10. **Refrain from being exclusive in my relationships.** If my sweetheart, fiancé, or spouse is on the team, we will make every effort to interact with all team members, not just one another. If I am attracted to a teammate, I will not attempt to pursue an exclusive relationship until after we return home.
11. **Refrain from any activity that could be construed as a romantic interest toward a local.**
12. **I understand that the Lee University community covenant is in full force during the trip.** Behaviors (alcohol/drug use, smoking, sexual activity) that violate the Covenant will be countered with early trip dismissal. Forfeit of fees paid/owed to the program, loss of trip course credit, and the added expense return airfare (and any extra costs incurred as a result thereof).
